A new loop, the Minnesota Moose Loop has been set this winter. It offers a ton of new mileage for your dog. There are several cut-throughs, so you can make a grand loop, or the whole zig-zag.

Most of Connors Bog is great terrain for beginners. It's relatively flat, and the straight utility corridor offers lots

of room to learn passing. Plus, most of those you meet will be fellow skijors, and hopefully a little tolerant of the occasional flying ski-tip. Have some fun!
